



VEGETATION MANAGEMENT RESERVE

MUNICIPALITY OF NORTH NORFOLK

BY-LAW # 31/2017

BEING a by-law to authorize the creation of a Vegetation Management Reserve Fund.

WHEREAS Subsection 168(1) of the *Municipal Act* S.M. 1996 c. 58 provides as follows:

“168(1) A council may by by-law establish reserve funds for any general or specific purpose.”

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Municipality of North Norfolk deems it expedient to create a Vegetation Management Reserve Fund;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Council of the Municipality of North Norfolk, in open Council assembled, enacts as follows:

- (1) **THAT** the municipality shall keep both in its books and in the bank a separate account designating the purpose for which the fund was created and showing at all times the state of the reserve fund created hereby;
- (2) **THAT** if the reserve fund or any portion thereof is invested the securities, therefore, shall be earmarked and kept separate from other securities of the Municipality;
- (3) **THAT** no portion of the reserve fund or any accretions thereto shall be applied or expended by the Municipality or the Council, or any member or officer thereof, for any purpose, unless approval of the Minister has been first obtained as stated in Subsection 168(2) of the *Municipal Act*;
- (4) **THAT** R.M. of North Norfolk By-Law #792/2012, being the Vegetation Management Reserve Fund, be rescinded.
