

## MUNICIPALITY OF NORTH NORFOLK ROAD CLOSING BY-LAW 15/2016

**BEING** a By-Law of **MUNICIPALITY of NORTH NORFOLK** to provide for the closing of a Public Lane, pursuant to Section 290 of *The Municipal Act.* 

**WHEREAS** Section 290 of *The Municipal Act* provides in part as follows:

A Municipality may close a municipal road by passing a By-Law, obtaining approval from the Minister charged with the administration of *The Municipal Act* and registering the By-Law and a Plan at the appropriate Land Titles Office.

**AND WHEREAS** the following municipal road is no longer required for public purposes and it is desirable and expedient and in the public interest that the same be closed;

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of the Municipality of North Norfolk in open session assembled hereby enacts as a By-Law as follows:

- 1. **THAT** all that portion of the Public Lane, Plan 230, in the SW ¼ 33-11-10 WPM shown bordered as Parcel A on a Plan of Survey prepared by Timothy William Longstaff, Manitoba Land Surveyor, and sworn to by him on the 20th day of January, 2016, on file in the Winnipeg Land Titles Office as Deposit No. 1891-2015, be and the same is hereby closed.
- 2. **THAT** all that portion of the Public Lane so closed shall be consolidated with the land described in Title 2610879/3, excepting all mines and minerals, title to which shall remain in the Crown.
- 3. **THAT** the Chief Administrative Officer is hereby authorized and directed to do all acts and execute all documents deemed necessary to carry out the terms of this By-Law.
